Our School

At Queen Elizabeth Public School, we provide experiences and learning opportunities which **reflect student interests and aptitudes**. This supports student's development of self-confidence, self-esteem and respect for others in a positive, "school family" atmosphere. This interest based learning environment affords children academic, social and personal growth which enables them to fuel their passion for learning.

Special Programs

A full time **French Immersion** setting is provided for students from Kindergarten to grade 3. Some instruction in English is provided starting in grade 3. In grade 4, 5, and 6, students receive equal instruction in both French and English. Our resource teacher supports in class **guided instruction** opportunities for all student's language development. Monthly assemblies recognize academic subject area excellence, whereas daily principal's awards focus on each student's strengths, interests and accomplishments.

Extra Curricular

Our students **initiate** and **engage** in a wide variety of extra curricular activities based on student interest. Some of these include: badminton, volleyball, robotics, choir, basketball, skating, snowshoeing, soccer, kickball, baseball, hockey, drama club, science Olympics, science fair (inventions), Grade 4 Swim Program, Eco Camp Bickell, cross country running, grade 5 Science North Trip, down hill skiing, public speaking etc. We even have our own game, called "Ring-O-Cl  roux".

Other Information About Our School

Our school's timetable is based on the Balanced School Day. Using this model, the day is organized into three (3) large blocks of instructional time broken up with two (2) nutritional and activity breaks. Music, daily physical activity and computer programming are a few of the highlights within a strong language/math based school environment. Finally, the instructional leaders within our school meet monthly as a Professional Learning Community where we share current pedagogy and research to help *REFINE* our best practice. By working together with all stakeholders, students at QEPS enjoy a rich and varied academic, social and personal experience.
